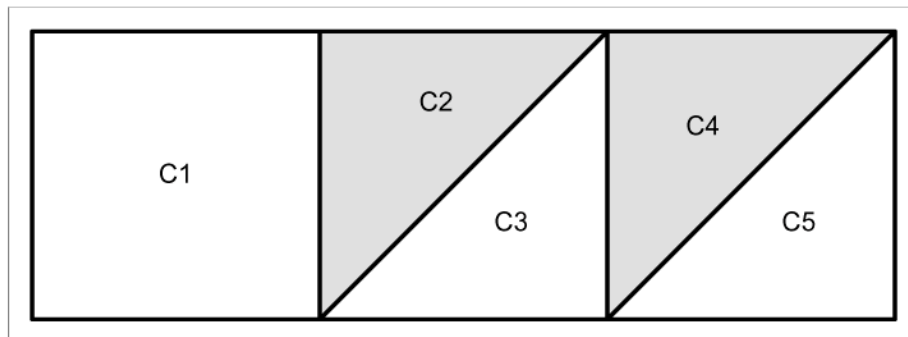
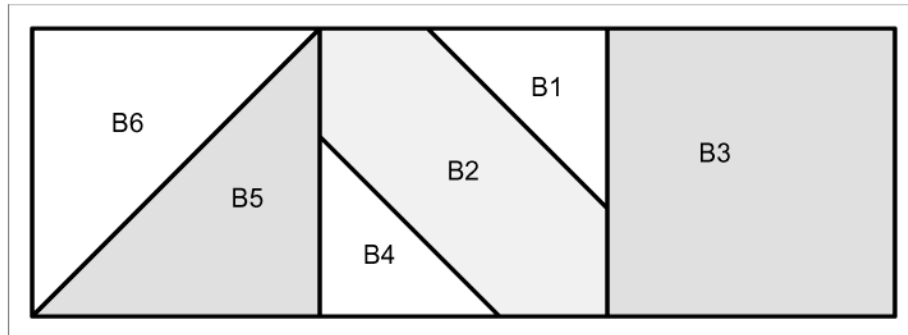
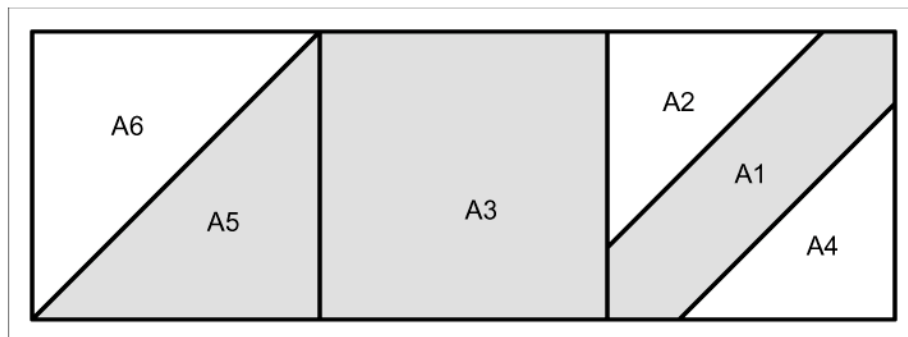

**Autumn Leaf**

Enlarge the foundation pattern 200% to make a 9" finished block.

Use colors of your choice for the leaf and sky. If desired, write your name in the center of the leaf with a pigma pen.

From:	Cut:	For:
Stem fabric	One 3½" square	A1
Leaf fabric	Two 3½" squares	A3, B3
	Two 3-7/8" squares	A5, B5, C2, C4
	One 3-1/8" square	B1/B4
Sky fabric	One 3½" square	C1
	Two 3-7/8" squares	A6, B6, C3, C5
		A2/A4
	One 3-1/8" square	
Light fabric	3½" square	B2



If you prefer, you can rotary cut the pieces for this block and piece it using traditional piecing methods. Cutting instructions for that method are shown.

Use the 3-7/8" squares to make half-square triangles.

Cut the 3-1/8" squares in half and sew them to either side of the appropriate 3-1/2" squares.

Join the blocks in rows as shown; sew the rows together to complete the block.
