NAME TAG/CELL PHONE BAG

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Class Description

Keep everything handy in this lightweight 7¼"H x 4¾"W bag. Vinyl and mesh pockets along with a zippered fabric pocket will hold a name tag or ID card, phone, and credit cards or cash.

A fabric strap, whose length is determined when binding the edges, can be customized to wear around the neck, over the shoulder, or crossbody.

The *Call Me* pattern is a perfect way to learn many of the basic techniques used to make ByAnnie patterns.

As you make this useful bag, you will learn how to:

- Quilt fabric with Soft and Stable
- Attach a zipper to quilted fabric
- Work with mesh and fold-over elastic
- Work with vinyl
- Make custom bias binding
- Bind raw edges on a flat project (including tips for going around corners, joining ends, and finishing binding)

These are all skills used in many of our patterns (including our larger travel bags/backpacks), so you'll be well on your way to many other bag-making adventures once you've mastered these techniques!

- Call Me* pattern
- Fabric and other supplies as listed in the pattern

ALSO BRING TO CLASS

- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. A non-stick foot is also helpful when sewing on vinyl. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto, pins (the large yellow-topped quilting pins work best), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, etc.

BEFORE CLASS

To make best use of class time, please complete these steps BEFORE coming to class:

- Follow the cutting and quilting instructions on page 1 of the pattern (**all of step I. Cut and Quilt**) to prepare all the pieces for the project.
