Class Description

Perfect for toiletries, electronic gear, shoes, and more, these functional bags in three sizes will keep you well-groomed and organized.

The double-zippered top opens easily for full access to the roomy interior.

Two exterior zippered pockets and two interior slip pockets keep things neat and organized.

A sturdy handle on one end makes carrying easy.

Learn easy techniques for working with Soft and Stable, sewing with mesh and fold-over elastic, installing zippers, making handles, assembling dimensional bags, attaching smooth, wrinkle-free bindings, and more as you make these handy bags.

We recommend that you make the medium or large bag in class. The small is a bit more challenging to assemble due to the "tight quarters".

ALSO BRING TO CLASS:

- ☐ Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, ¼" foot, and zipper foot. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- ☐ Rotary cutter and rulers
- ☐ Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto, pins (we prefer both the large yellow-topped quilting pins and extra-fine silk pins), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, etc.

BEFORE CLASS:

- ☐ To make best use of class time, please gather all supplies and complete ALL of step I. Cut and Quilt and Cut on pages 2 and 3 of the pattern BEFORE coming to class. Begin by gathering supplies and cutting out the fabrics and Soft and Stable. Then layer and quilt the selected pieces. Finally cut out the quilted pieces and seal their edges. Be sure to attach labels (included in the pattern) to everything as you work.

NOTE: One 1-yard (36" x 58") package of Soft and Stable will make all three bags

Mesh fabric* (pockets) SUP209	11" x 11"	12" x 13"	16" x 16"
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NOTE: One ½-yard (18" x 54") package of mesh will make pockets for all three bags.

Handbag zippers* ZIP30, ZIPYD

To ensure that the flap and body fit together properly, #4.5 handbag zippers are essential for this project. Two 30" double-slide zippers or at least 45" (53") [64"] of Zippers by the Yard and four pulls will make all the zippers for this project.

1" polypro strapping* SUP164-1	5"	6½"	8½"
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Fold-over elastic, 20mm* (inner pocket bindings) SUP211	1¼ yard	1½ yards	2 yards
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¾" hook & loop tape* SUP169	1½"	2"	2½"
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Thread to match fabrics	We recommend Superior Threads' So Fine! #50
