- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, ¼" foot, and zipper foot. Don't forget the extension table for your machine, too.
- ☐ Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto/pressing tool, pins (the large yellow-topped quilting pins work best), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, etc.
